

The glass is complete. It includes a bowl, a stem and a foot. The bowl has a straight rim, with a slightly convex wall that tapers towards the stem. The stem is solid and cylindrical. The foot is circular, with a truncated cone profile at the top. The underside has a slight circular indentation and a trace of pontil on the central glass; None, other than the shape of the glass.
