The bottle is complete. It is cylindrical in shape, with a straight wall, a rounded shoulder and a long, tapering cylindrical neck. The neck has a straight ring and a high, slightly tapered lip with a flat top. The base is straight. The base has a domed fulcrum, a sunken cone-shaped center and an annular plateau. There are three mold marks: a horizontal mold line at the top of the wall and two vertical mold lines on the shoulder and neck; None...
