This type of stopper would have been suitable for a square bottle or carafe made of colorless glass. This type of container was used to store strong alcoholic beverages, which were often kept in wooden cellars ; The decoration is molded and carved. The stopper head is shaped like a cone, with the surface cut into diamond-shaped facets.
