The cut is complete. It is cylindrical in shape. Its wall is high, slightly flared towards the rim, which is also flared. At its base, the bowl curves towards the foot. The foot is circular in shape, with a truncated cone profile at the top, and is thick. The underside has a slight off-center circular depression. The inner bottom has circular markings. The base is slightly frosted, with numerous linear markings ; The decoration is molded. It is geometric. The lower two-thirds of the bowl are decorated with straight flutes with flat, recessed tops.
