The cut is complete. It is cylindrical in shape. Its wall is high, slightly flared towards the rim, which is also flared. At its base, the bowl curves towards the stem. The base is thick and rounded on the inside. The stem is solid and cylindrical, with a flattened central knob. The foot is circular in shape, with a truncated cone profile at the top; it is thick. The underside shows a trace of glass pontil. The inner base has circular markings. The base is slightly frosted, with numerous linear marks ; The decoration is blown. It is geometric on the stem. The stem is decorated with a flattened button at mid-height.
