The bottle is complete. It is square with rounded corners. The sides are tapered at the sock and domed at the top; the shoulder is rounded, the neck short and tapered at the top. The neck is short and tapered upwards, with a high lip tapering upwards and a flat top. There are two vertical mold lines on opposite corners, starting at the base and extending over the shoulder to another horizontal, bulging line below the neck; the neck has two vertical mold lines. The base has a rounded fulcrum; the center is recessed and flat. It features a molded mark in relief, consisting of two letters: D S (D entourant S); The decoration is molded: the walls feature fine parallel vertical striations. The decoration is geometric.
