The plate is circular with a wavy rim. It is complete, with the exception of a few small chips on the rim. The rim is thick and domed. The rim is slightly inward, with a small bulge at its junction with the wall; the wall is curved and the base is slightly domed. On the reverse, the plate rests on a milled foot; the bottom is recessed and flat. The glaze is cracked on the front and

reverse; the paste, originally white, is now beige; the decoration is molded and painted blue; it is Shell-edged. The molded decoration is present on the marli, near the rim. It consists of slightly undulating striations perpendicular to the rim. The upper two-thirds of these striations have been painted blue; the rim of the plate has also been painted blue.
