The plate is complete. It is circular with a plain rim. The rim slopes slightly inwards, while the wall curves towards the flat base. On the reverse, it rests on the base. On the reverse, the junction between the wall and the base is rounded. There are three debossed marks under the bottom: WEDGWOOD M K, and a brown painted mark: H. There are a few linear

marks on the inner bottom. There are numerous wear marks on the reverse of the background; the decoration is painted over the glaze. It is visible on the marli, near the rim; it is a brown-edged motif. It consists of a narrow braid underlined by a line. The border is also decorated with a medallion surrounding a monogram (probably ED), topped by a garland of trifoliate foliage; all painted brown over glaze.
