The plate is complete. It is circular in shape, with an undulating rim. The rim slopes slightly inwards, and the wall is low and curved towards the bottom, which is flat without a foot. On the reverse side of the plate, below the base, there is an intaglio print of a crowned rose. There is also an eyelet welded to the back of the plate, at the junction of the bottom and the wall ;

The decoration is molded and embossed. The molded decoration is visible around the rim and on the marli. The rim is corrugated. The decoration on the marli is visible near the rim: it consists of a slight bulge followed by a small channel, both following the wavy contour of the plate rim. The marli also features a slight, triangular bulge, perpendicular to the marli, in line with the pinches visible around the rim. The embossed decoration was used to form the coat of arms visible on the plate, which occupies the center of the base. It consists of a shield decorated with three heart-like elements arranged in a triangle. The shield is surmounted by a marquis's crown.
